Value	Description
A-1 Foreign government worker	This indicates an ambassador, public minister, career diplomat, or consular officer, and members of the immediate family.
A-2 other foreign government official and family	This indicates other foreign government officials and members of immediate family.
A-3 Attendant, servant or employee of A-1 or A-2	This indicates an attendant, servant, or personal employee of noncitizen holding an A-1 or A-2 visa, and members of immediate family.
ASLM Political asylum	This indicates a person granted political asylum by the United States.
B-1 Visitor for business	This indicates a person who may accept an honorarium payment and payment for associated incidental expenses for an academic activity not lasting longer than nine days at any single institution and limited to five institutions during any six-month period.
B-2 visitor for pleasure	Individuals with this visa are not employable in the RF..
C-1 Continuous transit alien	Individuals with this visa are not employable in the RF.
C-2 Alien in transit to United Nations headquarters	Individuals with this visa are not employable in the RF.
C-3 Foreign official, family, servants in transit	Individuals with this visa are not employable in the RF.
CPO Chinese protective order (Oct 90)	This indicates a person entering the United States under the Chinese protective order (October 1990).
CPR Conditional permanent resident (spouse-two years)	This indicates an individual who is employable with restrictions.
D-1 Crewman	This indicates individuals who are not employable.
E-1 Treaty trader	This indicates individuals who are employable only by the treaty-qualifying company through which the person attained his or her status. Dependents are not employable.
E-2 Treaty investor	This indicates individuals who are employable only by the treaty-qualifying company through which the person attained his or her status. Dependents are not employable.
EWI Entry without inspection	This indicates that individual's employment status is unknown. Refer to INS for status clarification.
F-1 Student	This indicates the individual who is employable with restrictions.

Value	Description
F-2 Student dependent	This indicates an individual who is employable only with a change in visa category.
G-1 Foreign government visitor	This indicates an individual who is employable only by a foreign government entity or the international organization.
G-2 Other representative of foreign member government	This indicates an individual who is employable only by a foreign government entity or the international organization.
G-3 representative of non-recognized government and family	This indicates an individual who is employable only by a foreign government entity or the international organization.
G-4 international organization officer or employee and family	This indicates an individual who is employable only by a foreign government entity or the international organization.
H-1A Professional Nurse	This indicates an individual who is employable only by the employer named on the visa petition.
H-1B Worker in specialty occupation	This indicates an individual who is employable only by the employer named on the visa petition.
H-2A Temporary worker performing agricultural services	This indicates an individual who is employable only by the employer named on the visa petition.
H-2B temporary worker	This indicates an individual who is employable only by the employer named on the visa petition.
H-3 Temporary trainee	This indicates an individual who is employable only by the employer named on the visa petition.
H-4 Worker dependent	Individuals with this visa are not employable.
H1B1 Specialty occupation	This indicates an individual who is employable only by the employer named on the visa petition.
H1B3 Artist/athlete of acclaim	This indicates an individual who is employable only by the employer named on the visa petition.
H1B4 Athlete	This indicates an individual who is employable only by the employer named on the visa petition.
H1B5 Athlete	This indicates an individual who is employable only by the employer named on the visa petition.
H1BS Essential Support	This indicates an individual who is employable only by the employer named on the visa petition.
I Representative of foreign media, spouse, children	This indicates a representative that may be employed only by the sponsoring news agency or bureau; dependents are not employable.
J-1 Code 01 students	This indicates an individual who is employable with restrictions.
J-1 Code 02 Short term scholars	This indicates an individual who is employable with restrictions.
J-1 Code 03 Trainees - nonmedical	This indicates an individual who is employable with restrictions.
J-1 Code 04 Teachers	This indicates an individual who is employable with restrictions.
J-1 Code 05 Professors	This indicates an individual who is employable with restrictions.
J-1 Code 06 Specialists	This indicates an individual who is employable with restrictions.

K-1 Fiancé of US citizen	This indicates an individual who is employable by any employer in any capacity; requires an INS employment authorization document.
L-1 intracompany transferee	This indicates an individual who is employable only by the U.S. entity for which the status was obtained.
L-2 intracompany transferee dependent	Individuals with this visa are not employable with the RF.
LPR US lawful permanent resident	This indicates an individual who is employable.
M-1 Non-academic student	This indicates an individual who may not accept employment or engage in business except for practical training with INS approval.
M-2 Non-academic student dependent	Individuals with this visa are not employable by the RF.
N-8 Parent of SK-3 special immigrant	This indicates an individual who is employable, requires INS employment authorization document.
N-9 Child of N-8 or SK-1, SK-2, or SK-4 special immigrant	This indicates an individual who is employable, requires INS employment authorization document.
NATO	This visa type is not seen at the RF.
O-1 Alien of extraordinary ability in science, art, education	This indicates Employable only by the specific employer approved by the INS in the original petition.
O-2 Accompanying alien	This indicates Individuals who are not employable.
O-3 Spouse, child or O-1 or O-2	This indicates Individuals who are not employable.
P-1 Performing entertainer	This indicates Individuals who are not employable.
P-2 Exchange program artist or athlete	This indicates Individuals who are not employable.
P-3 Culturally unique artist or entertainer	This indicates Individuals who are not employable.

Value	Description
Q-1 Cultural exchange visitor	This indicates an individual who is employable only by specific employers approved by the INS.
Q-1 Old Q-1 cultural exchange visitor	This indicates an individual who is employable only by specific employers approved by the INS.
R-1 Religious worker	Individuals with this visa are not employable by the RF.
R-2 Religious worker dependent	This indicates Individuals who are not employable by the RF.
RFGE Refugee	This indicates an individual who is employable.
SK-1 Special immigrant	This indicates Employable, requires INS employment authorization document.
SK-2 Special immigrant	This indicates an individual who is employable, requires INS employment authorization document.
SK-3 Special immigrant	This indicates an individual who is employable, requires INS employment authorization document.
TN Canadian or Mexican citizen professional	This indicates a person who is employable.
WWB Visa waiver business	This type of visa not usually seen by the RF.
WWT Visa waiver tourist	This type of visa not usually seen by the RF.
WB1 Canadian walkover for business	This type of visa not usually seen by the RF.
WB2 Canadian walkover for pleasure	This type of visa not usually seen by the RF.
