Since August 2013, Ms. Hoselton has served as Assistant Vice President and RF Operations Manager at SUNY New Paltz and is responsible for the overall administration of externally funded research and sponsored program activity, including pre-award and post award administration and research compliance. Areas of compliance under her responsibility include human subjects research, for which she is the Human Protections Administrator, animal research, biosafety, conflicts of interest, and export controls.
