 - Aging: Add a new folder from Customer Collection Form from Oracle Applications
- Account Payables Subject Area:
 - Vendor Site Code data is not returning
- Grants Snapshot Subject Areas:
 - Project Credit Distribution: Add a new folder "Organization Hierarchy" with Organization Hierarchy data elements
 - Terms and Conditions: Add a new data element Project Number and Task Number
 - Add a new folder "Project Role" with the same data elements that we have in the Post Award Management subject area
- Usage Tracking Subject Area:
 - Add a new folder "User Name" with the data elements "Employee Number", "Full Name", and "Operating Location"

Figure A: Data element is located in the Date folder>Month End Date>Month End Date List

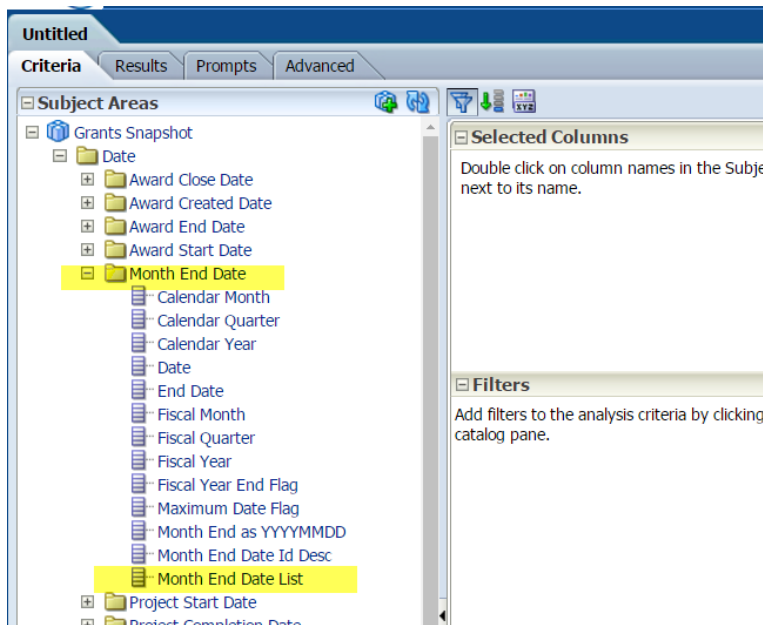


Figure B: This illustration shows how you would create a filter on Month End Date List to bring in multiple years.
