## Graph Enhancements for Report Center

In this new upgraded version graphs have been enhanced to allow the end user the ability to sort graph views by using a context menu (right-click). A new sort dialog is displayed when you right-click in a graph view in the analysis editor, Results tab. You can right-click legend, data marker, and group-level (X axis) items to display a menu of interactions that includes options such as Sort and Drill. We have provided screen shots and an example below.
