

## Disclosure of Criminal History

This disclosure form should be used for applicants in Buffalo, Rochester, Westchester, Suffolk County and New York City.

Applicants for employment in Buffalo, Rochester, Westchester, Suffolk County and New York City are required to complete a disclosure document of criminal history only after a conditional offer of employment has been extended.

Applicants are not required to disclose information pertaining to sealed conviction records, youthful offender adjudications, or criminal charges that have been resolved in favor of the applicant (e.g. dismissal).
