The following table provides definitions of the values for Veteran Status in the RF's business system.

Value	Description
Disabled Veteran	A Special Disabled Veteran, a person who is entitled to compensation (or who but for the receipt of military retired pay would be entitled to compensation) under laws administered by the Veterans Administration for a disability rated at 30 percent or more; or rated at 10 or 20 percent in the case of a veteran who has been determined under Section 1506 of Title 38, U.S. Code, to have a significant employment handicap; or a person who was discharged or released from active duty because of a service-connected disability. The term "significant employment handicap" means a significant impairment of a veteran's ability to prepare for, obtain, or retain employment consistent with such veteran's abilities, aptitudes, and interests.
Disabled Vietnam Veteran	This value should not be chosen; it is not used by the Research Foundation.
Disabled Vietnam and Other	This value should not be chosen; it is not used by the Research
Protected Veteran	Foundation.
Not a Veteran	A person with no military service. This value is not used by the Research Foundation.
Other Protected Disabled Veteran	This value should not be chosen; it is not used by the Research Foundation.
Other Protected Veteran	A person with active duty service at any point between December 7, 1941 and April 28, 1952, or a veteran who served in a campaign or on an expedition for which a campaign badge has been authorized. The campaigns or expeditions that meet this criterion are identified via the Internet at http:// www.opm.gov/ VETERANS/html/ vgmedal2.htm. A veteran qualifies under this criterion only based upon military service in the identified campaign or expedition and not simply based on any military service during the time of the campaign or expedition. The campaign badges, service medals, and expeditionary medals that qualify under this criterion will be listed on Form DD-214, "Armed Forces of the U.S. Report of Transfer or Discharge" if the veteran meets this criterion.
Veteran	This value should not be chosen; it is not used by the Research Foundation.

Value	Description
Vietnam Veteran	A Vietnam Era Veteran, a person who served more than 180 days of active military service, any part of which was during the period August 5, 1964 through May 7, 1975, or any part of which was during the period from February 28, 1961 through May 7, 1975 if the person served in the Republic of Vietnam, and who was discharged or released from active duty with other than a dishonorable discharge, or was discharged or released from active duty because
	of a service-connected disability.
Vietnam and Other Protected Veteran	This value should not be chosen; it is not used by the Research Foundation.
